Chief Dean Sayers April Update



This year has been challenging for a lot of our families. We've lost a lot matriarchs and patriarchs, and some of our young folks as well have moved on to the spirit world. I pray our families find comfort and solace in watching the change of the seasons, even though times may be challenging.

During the March break, Batchewana sent a total of six teams to the LNHL tournament in Mississauga Ontario. This year Marked the 50th anniversary of the LNHL tournament. It would be great if we had the ability to host this tournament in the northern communities again by possibly dividing the tournament into two tournaments with younger kids during the first part of the March break and the older kids during the last part of the March break. This would reduce the number of teams at one time which would allow other First Nations the opportunity to host and showcase their territories.

The RHT Litigation Fund, known to some as the four dollar a year issue (Annuities) is nearing completion. Each of the parties, which include Canada, Ontario, and First Nations are closer to a negotiated settlement. Once the parties agree to a final number, there will be an announcement coming directly from Batchewana First Nation on the specific details as they pertain to our membership.

Culture, Confidence and Competence (CCC) is an essential skills workforce training program designed by and for Indigenous women and diverse people. The cultural foundation of this innovative program supports a journey of self reflection, career exploration, and skill building experiences that prepare members to obtain and retain jobs across multiple employment sectors and to become entrepreneurs. Members of the CCC develop individualized training plans and are streamed into worksite placements, jobs or other relevant referral agencies. A training allowance and wrap around supports (e.g. childcare, technology, and transportation) are offered to reduce barriers to participation. Co-ed training programs are offered at the request of communities.
