First Nation will be held at the <u>Thunderbird Room</u>, Rankin Arena on Wednesday, the <u>14th</u> day of <u>June</u> 2023, beginning at <u>6:00 p.m.</u> and closing at <u>9:00 p.m.</u>, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the position of Chief and Councillors, on the Band Council of the said Band, for the next ensuing term. There is <u>one</u> (1) Chief position and <u>eight</u> (8) Councillor positions available.

The Election will be held on the <u>Thunderbird Room</u>, Rankin Arena on Friday the <u>28th</u> day of <u>July</u> 2023.

Please note that <u>any voter may nominate candidates by using a mail-in nomination form</u>. You can either deliver or mail-in a written nomination and a completed, signed and witnessed voter declaration form to the Electoral Officer before the time set for the Nomination Meeting <u>OR</u> you may nominate candidates or ally at the nomination meeting. Also note that any voter may vote by mail in ballot. If you will not be available to vote in person on the Polling Day, you may make arrangements with the Electoral Officer to receive a mail in ballot.

Batchewana First Nation Jurisdictional Advisory Committee

"We need to form our own government, not be part of the Indian act, all children need to be identified, with there traditional name, we need to act accordingly."

Chief and Council have set in motion the plan to form our own government. The Batchewana First Nation (BFN) <u>Jurisdictional Advisory Committee</u> (JAC) is a working group with the focus on our rights. The Vision Statement and Terms of Reference for this Committee were approved by Chief & Council Motion #7 on March 1, 2023. Members appointed to the Committee are: Cathy Alisch, Carol Nadjiwan, RJ Dalton, Councillor Harvey Bell, Councillor Mark McCoy, Chair/Councillor Greg Agawa and Gimma Dean Sayers.

The Terms of Reference (ToR) for this Committee corroborates a cooperative (and collaborative) working relationship amongst the Chief & Council and the Chief Governance Officer & Governance Office. The shared collective goal is the successful implementation of the Vision Statement and the Notice of Assertions. Significant to success is going to be the continued involvement and engagement of our BFN Band Members. For alignment, efficiency, and effectiveness of BFN resources, the Jurisdictional Advisory Committee's projects, events, or actionable measures are to be presented to Chief and Council before any implementation or action.

The Jurisdictional Advisory Committee's responsibility and mandate is (per the approved terms of reference):

"To provide clear and concise recommendations and planning, to the Chief & Council, as well as strategic response items, situations, or issues involving our People and homeland (aki)."

In alignment with the JAC, there will be Helpers (human resources) to navigate and track change as we unlearn not to be part of the Indian Act. The planned human resources for the Governance (Gimaakndaadwin) Hub (Office) are a Chief Governance Officer, Writer, Policy Analyst, Researcher, Administrative Support, and Public Relations Manager. The task of this Hub is to bring to life the BFN inherent cultural/custom laws that have been stored within our knowledge systems. Work has begun with bringing to light BFN historical and cultural knowledge systems, including oral and written Anishinaabe knowledge. These traditions, customs, teachings, and oral stories will be the foundation for BFN Custom Governance as we put action to the "Assertions".

The task is purposed with breaking away from colonial law. A major task that will definitely have challenges. The Governance Hub can be likened to a cartographer, a map maker who will plot a path from the directions (input, feedback, insights, experiences) shared by BFN Band Members. We are going to rely heavily upon Knowledge Keepers and Community Members to build insight, analysis and recommendations that reveal and re-establish our own knowledge systems for self-

governance. This will come as the map takes life, we will be able to see the interrelationships and manner of contributions from all BFN Citizens (Band Members), Leadership (Chief & Council or Clan Leaders), and BFN Shkaabewis (Helper) Hubs. Our growth as it is mapped will be guided by the traditions, customs, practices, teachings and the gifts of our Ancestors. Foremost will be the inclusion of the Children learning their identity, along with the decision whether to participate in traditional naming ceremonies. And, as pointed out, we need to act accordingly which necessitates each BFN Band Member taking an active role in the plan for sustaining the care, well-ness and wellbeing of the Bawahting Territory, home to the BFN Citizens and future generations.

The Jurisdictional Advisory Committee invites and welcome BFN Band Members to the Rankin Lodge on Wednesday July 5, 2023 at 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. We will be introducing the Committee to the BFN Membership followed by a feast.
