BILL C-38 & REGISTRATION

UPDATE FROM INDIGENOUS SERVICES CANADA

ON DECEMBER 14, 2022, BILL C-38, AN ACT TO AMEND THE INDIAN ACT (NEW REGISTRATION ENTITLEMENTS), WAS INTRODUCED IN PARLIAMENT. BILL C-38 PROPOSES CHANGES TO ADDRESS THE ISSUES OF ENFRANCHISEMENT, DEREGISTRATION, ACQUIRED RIGHTS TO NATAL BAND MEMBERSHIP AND TO REPLACE SOME OUTDATED AND OFFENSIVE LANGUAGE IN THE INDIAN ACT.

What is the proposed amendment for this issue?

The proposed amendments would ensure that people with a family history of enfranchisement are treated equally to with those without. This includes:

Repealing the enfranchisement-related provisions of 6(1)(d) and (e) and transferring individuals entitled for registration under these provisions to 6(1)(a.1);

Entitling direct descendants of individuals who are, were or would have been entitled to be registered under 6(1)(d) and (e) under the provision 6(1)(a.3), if they were: born before April 17, 1985, whether or not their parents were married to each other at the time of the birth, or born after April 16, 1985, and their parents were married to each other at any time before April 17, 1985.

Restoring entitlement to individuals who enfranchised as part of a collective, under section 6(1)(a.1)

Steps you may wish to take if you think you are newly entitled as a result of Bill C-38

We are pleased to be able to encourage you, your family and anyone you know who may be newly entitled as a result of Bill C-38, to submit their application for registration.

There is absolutely no need to wait until the Bill passes to do so. Applications are processed on a first-come first-served basis. The Department has developed a specific application processing queue for Bill C-38 impacted applications to ensure that they will be processed efficiently. Your file will only get an official decision if and/or when the Bill receives Royal Assent.

(1876-1920)

Occurred when an individual:

- •attained a university degree
- became a "professional"
- met the "fit", "sober", "moral",and/or "civilized" requirements of the day
 - •became a priest or minister
- •lived outside of Canada for more than five years without permission

ENFRANCHISEMENT BY
APPLICATION

(1876-1985)

occurred if an individual or collective:

- •showed they were "fit" to enter Canadian society
 - wanted to access the rights of Canadian citizenship
- needed a strategic way to protect children from being forced to attend residential schools

Medical Transportation Outside the Sault Ste. Marie Area



Do you require assistance with medical transportation and associated costs to attend a medical appointment outside the Sault Ste. Marie area?

Batchewana First Nation can assist BFN members who require assistance to attend a medical appointment outside of the Sault Ste. Marie area, through the Non-Insured Benefits Program.

Assistance can be provided through such supports as advancement of funds for mileage and meals, securing accommodations, alternative transportation, etc.

- Submission of notice of appointment must be received no later then 10 days prior to the scheduled appointment, but preferable within two weeks of appointments.
- 2. Required information:
 - Full Name (first, middle & last name)
 - First Nation Registration/Status #
 - Date of Birth
 - Phone Number(s)
 - Residential Address
 - Doctors Note with:
 - ✓ Appointment Date, Time, Address,
 - ✓ Type of appointment
 - ✓ Specialists Contact Information

- **Escort Note** from Doctor (if client requires an escort)
- Notice of appointment and copy of referral (if required)
- Post Confirmation of Appointment Attendance from previous appointment (if required)
- NIHB medical transportation will be coordinated with client and Batchewana Health Centre. Any change orders after the initial one (1) request performed by BFN staff will be limited to two (2) subsequent changes. Any further requests will be considered on a discretionary basis considering exceptional circumstances and/or clients will be directed to make their own arrangements directly with NIHB Regional for their direct approval and reimbursement.
- 4. Submission of Confirmation of Appointment attendance is due back to the BFN Staff member at the Batchewana Health Centre within 2 weeks of your appointment attendance. Failure to submit your confirmation of appointment attendance will jeopardize your ability to receive future financial supports.

Failure to supply all required documentation as requested, may result in a delay in application, approval and financial assistance.

There is **NO Guarantee** that applications will be approved, if they are submitted less than 10 days prior to medical appointment.
